

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Adopted: 2026-05-28

1. Purpose

For the purpose of fulfilling the requirements for policy commitments under section 3.1.3 in the area of environment. This environmental policy establishes the company's continuous work to improve the company's and supply chain's relationship to and impact on the environment, in accordance with Möbelfakta's framework for responsible supply chains. The policy has been developed in accordance with applicable legislation and requirements within Möbelfakta's framework for responsible supply chains.

2. Overall commitment and compliance with the law

The company shall conduct its operations with the greatest possible regard for the environment and work to minimize negative environmental impact throughout the product's life cycle - from raw materials to final recycling. We undertake to comply, as a minimum, with national and local environmental legislation in the countries where we or our suppliers operate. We work actively to promote climate action that contributes to achieving national and international climate goals.

3. Chemicals, materials, and biodiversity

We ensure that no prohibited or particularly hazardous substances (SVHC) are present in our products in concentrations higher than 0.1% by weight. All materials such as wood, plastic, textiles, metal, adhesives and surface treatments must meet applicable requirements. Wood-based materials must be legally harvested and traceable. We maintain an updated list of names and addresses of all manufacturing facilities where our furniture and components are produced. We apply a specific action plan to continuously increase traceability back in the chain for critical materials such as wood, textile and steel. Our responsibility for biodiversity means that no raw materials are used from species listed in CITES or assessed as threatened according to the IUCN Red List, and that we have procedures that ensure that all wood material is legally harvested, traceable and respects legal rights of use.

4. Circular economy and product responsibility

We strive to develop products that are durable, repairable and recyclable. Plastic components should be labeled; spare parts should be available and warranty terms should be clear.

5. Emissions, waste, climate, and energy

The company ensures that all waste is handled, stored and transported in a manner that protects both the environment and health from harmful impacts. We work systematically to reduce or eliminate emissions that reduce climate impact and pose an environmental hazard and promote active strategies for efficient water use in our own operations as well as in our supply chain through energy efficiency, minimized transportation and continuous improvement of production processes.

6. Environmental Rights

We respect the right to a safe, clean and sustainable environment and do not accept any illegal eviction or takeover of land, forests or water under any circumstances. We recognize and respect the rights of others to natural resources, including the rights of indigenous peoples and the principle of free, prior and informed consent for the use of their traditional territories.

7. Risk analysis and follow-up

To identify, prevent and mitigate environmental non-conformities, we apply a risk-based approach that includes regular and documented risk analyses throughout the supply chain. We establish clear action plans for identified risks, apply purchasing methods that support our suppliers, and maintain systems to handle complaints and provide redress in the event of actual negative impacts.

8. Responsibility

Management bears overall responsibility for implementing the environmental policy and allocating the necessary resources to maintain the due diligence process. Should serious environmental damage be identified in our own operations or in the supply chain, we undertake to report the circumstances and planned actions to Möbelfakta (info@mobelfakta.se) within two weeks.


